

# 2020 Fellows Scholarship Requirements

Community Oncology Alliance (COA) will sponsor the following number of travel awards annually for the following events/board meetings.

- Annual COA Conference (6)
- Annual Board Meeting (2)
- Payer Exchange Summit (2)

\*Travel award is only good for airfare and lodging. Meals will be provided during each program. All other meals and ground transportation are the responsibility of the recipient.

## **Applicant Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must attend the entire session of each event
- 2. Applicant must attend the Fellows Workshop and all related Fellows educational events scheduled Wednesday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> thru Friday April 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. Applicant must be interested in community oncology
- 4. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a Hematology/Oncology or Radiation Oncology Fellowship Program
- 5. Applicant asked to write a short paragraph detailing the benefits of attendance
- Applicant asked to write a short assessment of his or her learning experience post conference

### **Submission to Include:**

- Updated CV
- One-page personal statement reflecting on each of the following:
  - Personal/Professional goals in attending the meeting
  - Impact that COA has had on your future decision-making
  - Likelihood of practicing in the private, community oncology setting

### **Deadline for Each Event:**

1. Annual COA Conference: February 29, 2020

2. Board Meeting: August 31, 2020

3. Payer Exchange Summit: October 1, 2020

### **Selection Process:**

- Application must be received in accordance with above deadlines
- Applications will be reviewed by the Director of Policy Analysis, COA
- Awards and formal announcement via COA newsletter and personal email
- Headshot, if available, desirable
