**Travel award includes airfare and lodging only. Meals will be provided during each program. All other meals and ground transportation are the responsibility of the recipient.*

Applicant Requirements:

1. Applicant must attend the entire session of each event
2. Applicant must attend the Fellows Workshop and all related Fellows educational events scheduled.
3. Applicant must be interested in community oncology
4. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a Hematology/Oncology or Radiation Oncology Fellowship Program
5. Applicant asked to write a short assessment of his or her learning experience post conference

Submission to Include:

- Updated CV, including PGY status & Headshot
- One-page personal statement reflecting on each of the following:
 - Personal/Professional goals in attending the meeting
 - Impact that COA has had on your future decision-making
 - Likelihood of practicing in the private, community oncology setting

Deadline for Each Event:

- Board Meeting: August 31, 2023
- Payer Exchange Summit: October 1, 2023
- Annual COA Conference: February 7, 2024

Selection Process:

- Application must be received in accordance with the above deadlines
- Applications will be reviewed by the Director of Development & Strategic Initiatives
- Awards and formal announcement via COA newsletter and personal email
