Applicant Requirements:

- 1. Applicant must attend the entire session of each event
- 2. Applicant must attend the Fellows Workshop and all related Fellows educational events scheduled.
- 3. Applicant must be interested in community oncology
- 4. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a Hematology/Oncology or Radiation Oncology Fellowship Program
- 5. Applicant asked to write a short assessment of his or her learning experience post conference

Submission to Include:

- Updated CV, including PGY status & Headshot
- One-page personal statement reflecting on each of the following:
 - o Personal/Professional goals in attending the meeting
 - \circ $\;$ Impact that COA has had on your future decision-making
 - Likelihood of practicing in the private, community oncology setting

Deadline for Each Event:

- Board Meeting: August 31, 2023
- Payer Exchange Summit: October 1, 2023
- Annual COA Conference: February 7, 2024
